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## **Manuscripts**

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Manuscripts should be written in English, French, German or Italian, and should be typewritten, double spaced, with generous margins. Diagrams should be drawn with black India ink on glossy white paper.

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Footnotes, except a possible acknowledgement of assistance or financial support on the first page, should be avoided by being incorporated into the text, perhaps parenthetically.
