## Expanded Coverage

*The Philosopher's Index* significantly expanded coverage in 1980. In the past, current issues of *The Philosopher's Index* indexed journal articles only. However, Volume XIV (1980) increased coverage to include original scholarly books in philosophy, plus bibliographies, biographies, translations, textbooks, dissertations, and anthologies. Contributions to anthologies are indexed as well as the work as a whole.

*The Philosopher's Index: A Retrospective Index to U.S. Publications from 1940* and *The Philosopher's Index: A Retrospective Index to non-U.S. English Language Publications from 1940* greatly enhance coverage of philosophy journals and books on a retrospective basis.

*Ratio* continues in a new form philosophical aims pursued with uncommon seriousness and courage in the *Abhandlungen der Fries'schen Schule*. The *Abhandlungen* were established in 1847 by Ernst Friedrich Apelt and re-established in 1904 by Leonard Nelson. Their publication was interrupted in 1937, but, in 1957, Julius Kraft, a pupil of Nelson, revived this work by founding *Ratio*.
