FIRST ANNUAL UNDERGRADUATE PAPER COMPETITION IN CRYPTOLOGY

We are pleased to announce this contest to encourage the serious study of all aspects of cryptology in the undergraduate curricula. The details follow:

Prize: Three hundred dollars

Contest Closing Date: 1 January 1982

The topic may be in any area of cryptology including technical, historical, and literary subjects.

Papers must be no more than 20 typewritten pages in length, double-spaced and fully referenced. Four copies must be submitted. Authors should keep one copy. Papers are to be original works which have not been published previously. Authors must be enrolled in an undergraduate curricula at the time of composition. Copies become the property of CRYPTOLOGIA and CRYPTOLOGIA assumes publication rights on all entires.

The papers will be judged by the Editors of CRYPTOLOGIA and the winner will be announced on 1 April 1982 with publication of the winning paper in the July 1982 issue of CRYPTOLOGIA.
