GUIDE TO AUTHORS

Electronic submissions should be emailed to ndjfl@nd.edu. Submissions in IATEX are preferable; if possible, in documentclass amsart. Although electronic submissions are preferred, typed manuscripts will be accepted. They may be sent to the *Editors* at the postal address below, attention Production Editor.

The authors should be aware that NDJFL at times uses blind review. The authors should design the submission to facilitate this possible process. This is especially important when the submission is not in LAT_EX.

NDJFL requires an abstract of no more than 150 words, a classification of the paper under 2000 Mathematics Subject Classification (see http://www.ams.org/msc), and one or more keywords which describe the paper.

If published, the manuscript will be typeset by the *NDJFL* to conform to its style. Page proofs are sent to authors for correction of errors that occur in composition. Any special composition costs arising from an author's revision of the text in proof may be charged to the author. Fifty reprints, without covers, will be supplied free of charge; covers or additional reprints may be purchased.

Manuscripts are accepted for review with the understanding that it is the original work of the author who has the legal ability to assign all rights in the work; that all persons listed as authors have given their approval for the submission of the paper; that the same work has not been and will not be published elsewhere, nor is presently submitted elsewhere; that all necessary permissions have been secured for content that is not original; and that any person cited as a source of personal communications has approved such citation.

Further, authors warrant that they have taken reasonable care in ensuring the work is true in fact, that it does not contain defamatory or illegal content, and that it does not infringe upon the rights of others. Authors will be asked to sign an assignment of copyright to the *NDJFL* so that the authors and publishers may be protected from misuse of copyrighted material.
