The Two Rivers Symposium Summer Symposium in Real Analysis XLIV

WHEN: June 20–24, 2022

WHERE: Orsay and Paris, France.

The Forty Fourth Annual Summer Symposium in Real Analysis will be held June 20–24, 2022 at the École Normale Supérieure (Paris, France) and the Université Paris-Saclay (Orsay, France), near the Seine and Yvette rivers.

The program includes hour long plenary talks by Z. Buczolich (Budapest), G. David (Orsay), A. Olevskii (Tel Aviv) and M. Pramanik (Vancouver). It will also include an inaugural address by J. Mawhin (Louvain-la-Neuve).

In addition to the principal lectures, we have a number of slots set aside for twenty minute talks. Young researchers are particularly encouraged to present their work. There will also be time set aside for collaborative work and, as usual, a major goal is to create an atmosphere encouraging easy exchange of ideas.

We will try to limit the conference fee as much as possible; considering that Paris is an expensive city, and depending on the total amount of support we will receive, we expect the conference fee can be kept around 500 Euros (including bed and board).
