The Finnish philosopher and logician Raili Kauppi died in Tampere in August 1995. The exact date of her departure remains uncertain. She was born in Helsinki on the 10th of April 1920. After graduating from school in Heinola in 1938, Raili Kauppi worked first at the Helsinki City Library, the director of which was the philosopher and logician Uuno Saarnio (1896 – 1977). Kauppi was a librarian from 1942 to 1950, a library council from 1950 to 1960, the director of the branch library of Kallio from 1960 to 1961, and an administrative assistant director from 1961 to 1963. While working as a librarian she studied theoretical philosophy at the University of Helsinki. She finished her master's degree in 1949, her *phil. lic.* in 1956, and her doctoral dissertation in 1961. In 1963 Kauppi continued her career as a Lecturer in library science at the University of Tampere and from 1964 as a Lecturer in philosophy both in Helsinki and Tampere. In 1966 she took
