#### WORKSHOP REPORT

Following the Conference, a joint U.S.-Polish Workshop in Real Analysis was held at the same location July 14–19, 1994. The workshop was organized from the Polish side by Władysław Wilczyński, Marek Balcerzak, Jacek Hejduk and Dorota Rogowska and from the American side by Krzysztof Ciesielski. It was financially supported by Lódź University for all local costs and by the National Science Foundation grant INT-9401673 for all the costs occurring in U.S., including the travel costs of the American participants.
