Expanded Coverage

The Philosopher's Index significantly expanded coverage in 1980. In the past, current issues of The Philosopher's Index indexed journal articles only. However, Volume XIV (1980) increased coverage to include original scholarly books in philosophy, plus bibliographies, biographies, translations, textbooks, dissertations, and anthologies. Contributions to anthologies are indexed as well as the work as a whole.

Manuscripts (including footnotes) should be double-spaced with wide margins. The editors request that the author's name and institutional affiliation be kept on a separate cover sheet whenever possible. Two copies should be sent to the Editors, Box 5, Notre Dame, Indiana 46556, U.S.A. We regret that manuscripts cannot be returned unless postage is included.

Page proofs are sent to authors for correction of errors that occur in composition. Any special composition costs arising from an author's revision of the text in proof will be charged to the author. Fifty reprints, without covers, will be supplied free of charge; covers or additional reprints may be purchased.
