The nature of current work in real analysis is driven by the exchange of ideas generated by real analysts rooted in one subdiscipline of real analysis but with wide ranging interests. This Symposium will highlight lectures by both leading experts and energetic new researchers. Specifically, Summer Symposium XXVII will emphasize recent important work in harmonic analysis, integration theory and a solution of the celebrated Gradient Problem as well as some of the achievements of younger mathematicians in real analysis. In addition, we will provide a vibrant forum for the discussion of research problems, and allot prime speaking time to recent doctoral recipients.
