Editorial Correspondence: Articles on pure and applied mathematics and editorial or other correspondence should be addressed to the Editor, the Tōhoku Mathematical Journal, Math. Institute, Tōhoku Univ., Sendai, Japan.

Preparation of Manuscripts: Manuscripts should be typewritten in duplicate, except complicated formulae, in English, French or German. Figures and diagrams should be drawn in proper size in Indian ink or sumi on separate sheets of paper. Footnotes should be numbered consecutively and typed on a sheet by themselves at the end of the manuscript—they will be inserted at the designated places in the text after galley proofs have been corrected. Footnotes should be reduced to a minimum and, whenever possible, replaced by references to a bibliography placed at the end of the article. Formulae are undesirable in footnotes.

Proofs: Authors ordinarily receive only galley proofs. Stylistic changes in proofs must be avoided as possible; authors will be charged for excessive corrections.

Reprints: Authors receive gratis, postage prepaid, one hundred reprints of each article. Additional reprints may be purchased if desired.
