At the occasion of the Spring meeting of the Illinois, Indiana and Michigan sections of the Mathematical Association, at Notre Dame, April 9-10, 1945, the University arranged a symposium of four lectures on topics of advanced college mathematics.

Three of these lectures are published in this booklet, while the fourth, on Algebra of Analysis, in enlarged form, appears as Number 3 of this series.
