

CONFERENCE ANNOUNCEMENT

Western Illinois University will host a five day conference, entitled:

A Symposium in Real Analysis:

Bounded Variation and Absolute Continuity
in Fourier Series and Surface Area Theory

during the period July 17-21, 1978. The principal lecturer will be Professor Casper Goffman of Purdue University. The administration of Western Illinois University has agreed to support this conference by providing for the use of Tanner Conference Center on campus at subsidized rates for all participants and by providing room and board funding for a limited number of participants. Western Illinois University is submitting a proposal to the National Science Foundation in an effort to gain recognition for this event as an N.S.F.-C.B.M.S. Regional Conference and thus obtain funds which would permit a larger number of funded participants as well as funds for travel.
