

THE NOVEMBER MEETING IN TALLAHASSEE

The five hundred ninety-fourth meeting of the American Mathematical Society was held at the Florida Agricultural and Mechanical University and at Florida State University in Tallahassee, Florida, November 16, 17. There were 224 persons present, including 138 members of the Society.

By invitation of the Committee to Select Hour Speakers for Meetings of the Society in the Southeast, Professor J. S. MacNerney of the University of North Carolina addressed the Society on the topic, *A linear initial-value problem*. Professor Israel E. Glover presided at the General Session.

Professors A. D. Wallace, R. W. Ball, W. L. Strother, and R. C. Meacham presided at the Sessions for Contributed Papers on Friday afternoon, and Haskell Cohen, T. L. Wade, Pasquale Porcelli and D. E. South presided at the Saturday morning sessions.
