Information for Authors

General information. The main languages of publication are English, French, German, and Russian. Contributions may also be accepted in other languages as determined by the linguistic capabilities of the editorial board and its referees (for the areas of specialization of the editors and the languages in which the editors are competent, refer to the list of editors on the inside front cover). Submit reviews to the Reviews Editor, submit all other items to the Corresponding Editor.

All contributions will be refereed. Copies of the referees' comments will be forwarded to the author along with the editor's decision.

Guidelines for submission of manuscripts. Submission by email is preferred, but not required. Electronic formats are preferred. Of electronic formats, $\mathcal{A}_{\mathcal{M}}\mathcal{S}$ -LaTeX is preferred. The editors can accept almost any electronic format. Hardcopy is also acceptable.

U f b h m . When references to personal letters, papers presented at meetings, and other unpublished material are used, copies should be made available to the Corresponding Editor if such material may be of help in the evaluation of the paper.

For the transliteration of the Cyrillic alphabet, we have adopted the current system in use by $h\ m$ as the general rule. Exceptions are made only in the case of names which have already attained a common accepted transliteration or when the person owning the name has selected a preferred transliteration.
