

THE OCTOBER MEETING IN GARDEN CITY

The six hundred fifteenth meeting of the American Mathematical Society was held at Adelphi University in Garden City, New York on Saturday, October 24.

There were 76 persons registered, including 60 members of the Society.

By invitation of the Committee to Select Hour Speakers for Eastern Sectional Meetings, Professor Jun-Ichi Igusa of the Johns Hopkins University addressed the Society on *Modular functions and theta functions*. Professor Richard C. Sacksteder introduced the speaker.
